

Hundreds of sorority members will join the City of Jacksonville in a festive celebratory kick-off as they watch the legendary Friendship Fountain light up in pink and green at dusk. The skyline will be further accentuated by the city's skyscrapers lit in the colors as well.





6/7 IKONIC at the Prime Osborn

Saturday's IKONIC features various entertainment room experiences such as Monte Carlo Nights (Casino), Pink Rose Tea Room, Harlem Nights (Cotton Club), Chill Factory, Havanna Night's (Cigar Bar & Lounge) and others. There will be live music of all genres, comedians, a casino experience, silent disco heavy hors d' oeuvres and networking opportunities. Last year's event made history as the largest presented fundraiser by an organization of color. It is open to the public and tickets are \$55.
